ABOUT

Huntingdon is a National Hunt racecourse operated by The Jockey Club and is best known as the home of the Peterborough Chase. The flat, right-handed circuit measures approximately one mile and three furlongs and provides excellent viewing, with nine fences to each circuit and an open ditch in front of the grandstand. The course stages a varied programme of jump racing, from relaxed weekday fixtures to popular weekend and feature meetings. Visitors can choose from general admission, hospitality and annual badge options, while the venue also provides dedicated facilities for owners, trainers and stable staff and hosts events outside the racing calendar.

EXPANDED PROFILE

Huntingdon is a welcoming National Hunt racecourse operated by The Jockey Club and located close to the A1 and A14 in Cambridgeshire. Its flat, right-handed circuit is approximately one mile and three furlongs, with nine fences to each circuit. Excellent sightlines and the open ditch in front of the grandstand allow racegoers to remain close to the action.

The best-known fixture is the Peterborough Chase, supported by a varied programme of weekday, weekend, community and feature racedays. Visitors can choose from general admission, restaurant dining, private boxes and other hospitality options. The venue also operates throughout the year for conferences, exhibitions, weddings and other events.

Daniel Craggs is General Manager, Katie Margaron is Clerk of the Course and Anna Ramplly supports customer relations, marketing and owners and trainers liaison. Huntingdon provides dedicated owners and trainers facilities, approximately 100 stables, badge arrangements for runners and a syndicate option subject to availability. The racecourse welcomes direct enquiries about racing, hospitality, sponsorship, venue hire and annual attendance packages.

THE HOME OF THE PETERBOROUGH CHASE

Huntingdon Racecourse is an established National Hunt venue in Cambridgeshire, operated by The Jockey Club and conveniently located near the A1 and A14. The flat, right-handed circuit measures approximately one mile and three furlongs, with nine fences to each circuit. Its excellent sightlines and the open ditch immediately in front of the grandstand create an engaging experience for committed racing followers and first-time visitors alike.

The course is best known as the home of the Peterborough Chase, a race with a distinguished history and a place among the season's important contests for high-class chasers. Huntingdon also stages weekday, weekend, community and feature meetings, offering a programme that ranges from relaxed local fixtures to major sporting occasions.

General admission, restaurant dining, private boxes and hospitality packages give visitors several ways to experience a raceday. Accompanied under-18s are admitted free at most Jockey Club fixtures, helping families and younger audiences discover the sport.

RACING, HOSPITALITY AND PARTNERSHIP

Huntingdon places considerable emphasis on the owners and trainers experience. Dedicated facilities include the Fairfax Saddles Owners and Trainers Suite, dining arrangements, parade-ring access and support from a named liaison team. The racecourse has approximately 100 stables, although capacity can vary during building works. Syndicates can ask about alternative badge arrangements through the owners and trainers team, subject to availability.

General Manager Daniel Craggs leads the racecourse. Katie Margaron is Clerk of the Course, Chris Sykes is Head Groundsman and Anna Ramplly supports customer relations, marketing and owners and trainers liaison. Their published contact details give racing professionals clear access to the team before a fixture.

Beyond racing, the site hosts conferences, exhibitions, weddings and corporate events. Sponsorship and partnership packages can connect businesses with local and national racing audiences. A sponsored Jumps Club listing can be updated monthly to promote forthcoming fixtures, hospitality, annual attendance packages, sponsorship inventory and community events.
